Prevents licking the incision area - recommended for dogs
- Pre-Surgical Blood Panel (\$36 ~ \$98)
\$36 = PreOp Panel (10 Chemistry Panels & CBC)
\$58 = Basic Panel (17 Chemistry Panels & CBC)
\$98 = Full Panel (17 Chemistry & CBC & Lytes & SDMA & T4 thyroid)
Optional for animals under 5 years of age, pre-op panel required for animals undergoing surgery that are 5 years of age or older
- Fecal Analysis sent to Lab (\$18)
Bring sample collected within 24 hours / kept refrigerated
- Anti-anxiety/calming medication for dogs (\$20)
Recommended large breeds, energetic or hard to restrict activity
- Anti-Vomiting medication (@ time of surgery)
\$1 per pound of animal's weight
- Anti-Vomiting medication (take home)
