Surgical Anesthetic Consent Waiver

It is important to understand the risk of surgery as well as anesthesia. Although extremely low, the risk of death is always present, just as it is for humans that undergo surgical anesthesia.

The Fox Valley Animal Welfare League employs well experienced licensed veterinarians in addition to using the highest quality materials for every procedure performed.

As the owner or agent of this animal, I authorize the Fox Valley Animal Welfare League to perform the surgical procedure as scheduled. I authorize the veterinarian to administer any treatment that may be deemed medically necessary during the course of the procedure.

I release and indemnify all Fox Valley Animal Welfare League employees, volunteers, and agents from all liability.

I understand that the veterinarian maintains the right to refuse to perform surgery on any animal that is deemed a health risk.

Your cat will receive a small green tattoo near the incision site. This is the universal standard indicating the cat has been spayed or neutered.

Purebred/Exotic cats will require anti-vomiting medication prior to surgery:

Blood Panels are required for any cat 5 years of age or older - optional if under 5 years.

- \$50 = PreOp (10 Chemistry Panel & CBC)
- \$75 = Basic (17 Chemistry Panel & CBC)
- \$125 = Full (17 Chemistry & CBC, Lytes, SDMA, T4)

Baby teeth should fall out by 6 months of age, If baby teeth are still present at 7 months of age they are considered retained and will likely require extraction to prevent misalignment, crowding and painful dental problems. We will extract them while under anesthesia when medically necessary.

Umbilical hernias (soft bulge on belly button) present after 4 months of age will likely require surgical repair to prevent dangerous strangulation. We will repair the hernia during the surgical procedure while under anesthesia when medically necessary.
