### VETERINARY CARE

*We highly recommend that you have your rabbit examined by a veterinarian knowledgeable in rabbit medicine at least once a year.* Please refer to the Exotic Animal Veterinary Hospital List included with your homecare information or the [Exotic Animal Vet Resources](#) on our website. Not only will an annual exam help to prevent a number of medical problems, but you will have a medical staff familiar with your rabbit in case of an emergency.
